The awards are as follows: \$1000.00, \$3000.00 or \$5000.00. These awards will be deposited to the Registrar of the accredited college or university of your choice.

The criteria headings are as follows: **Academics, Written Presentation, Leadership experience, Volunteer experience, Sport/Athletics experience.**

The Scholarship is named in honour of the late Glenn Kimmett. Brother Kimmett was an active member of Ironworkers Local 721, an officer, a talented tradesman and a steadfast volunteer of his time and effort in building the Local Union and the Training Centre from the early beginning, through 40+ years of active service as a working member. All applicants will be contacted with a response to their submission and a decision of the Committee will be delivered at the **September 18th Membership Meeting in 2024.**
